The academic year 2024-25 was a time of learning and celebration. Our students engaged in various events both inside and outside the school, earning recognition for our institution. We provide a supportive environment where education and extracurricular activities are integrated, allowing students to express their talents. Our dedicated management, teachers, staff and resources play a vital role in shaping each student's character.

We believe that the values and lessons learned at school empower our students to pursue their dreams. We also want to thank our parents for their continued support, which has helped us achieve many milestones this year.

Below are the highlights of some of the achievements received this academic year:

- Our school has proudly reached a significant milestone by launching our state-of-the-art Robotics Lab, cutting-edge Artificial Intelligence Lab, and comprehensive Digital Library. Furthermore, we have successfully renovated the Art Room, uplifted the School Entrance and enhanced the School Pathway, to promote a better educational environment and resources.
- The school received the NELTAS Best School Award for both M-CAT and S-CAT. Principal and Ms. Richa earned special awards for their contributions.
- The school held its first Model United Nations conference, St. Michael's Magnanimous MUN 1.0 with 66 delegates from various Delhi NCR schools.

Shourya Sharma (11E) won High Commendation in the AIPPM committee at Bal Bharti. Samarth (9E) and Ambika (11R) received verbal acknowledgments for their performances at JDMC College.
- Lavanya Sabhnani (12E) won first prize in 32nd Fr. Peter Mermier Inter-School English Debate Competition organized by St. Francis de Sales School. She received a trophy, certificate, and a cash prize of ₹1500.
- Anjali Toppo (class 3 Rose) and M.C. Suan Cin Khup (class 11E) secured 3rd place at the Annual Catechism Exam 2023-24 organised by Delhi Catholic Archdiocese for classes 3 to 9 and class 11.
- The school choir was awarded the 3rd position in the zonal patriotic singing competition organized by the Directorate of Education at Salwan Girls Senior Secondary School, Old Rajender Nagar.
